Abstract:	<p>The Ministry of National Defense in accordance with 1 / o article. Organic Law of the Mexican Army and Air Force and the 38 article / o. the Civil Protection Act through the Regions, Zones, Military Units and other agencies, cooperating with the three levels of government (Federal, State and Municipal), developed activities for supporting the civil population in case of disaster.</p> <p>For that the Ministry of Defense established the Relief Plan for the Civilian Population in Disaster, called Plan DN-III-E, military operational tool sets out general guidelines to the agencies of Mexican Army and Air Force to carry out relief activities the civilian population affected by any type of disaster.</p> <p>This plan was developed and implemented in 1966 as a result of overflow Panuco River, its name dates from the same year, following its inclusion in the National Defense Planning as Annex "E" and although in subsequent revisions of the defense plan has been presented with the choice of giving it another name, the High Command Secretary of National Defense, decided to continue designating it as "Plan DN-III-E", due to identification under this name have civil authorities, media and general population.</p> <p>The DN-III-E actions are social work activities which are developed by the Ministry of National Defense, in coordination with Federal, State and Municipal to take care the rural, suburban and marginalized areas that don't have access to basic services.</p>
