TITLE	<b>RESTORE TEETH AFTER ENDODONTIC TREATMENT WITH ONLAY/PARTIAL CROWN</b>

Abstract:	<p>Crown restoration is the traditional way to restore and protect posterior teeth after endodontic treatment. To better conservative the residual tooth structure, we tried to use onlay/partial crown instead of crown to repair such teeth. Totally 66 metal and 100 porcelain onlays have been done from April 2006 to April 2009. And been luted with resin cement. Patients were invited to have a recall every 6 months. 7 onlays (4.2%) failed due to following reasons: 3 took off , 2 got secondary caries , 1 cracked and 1 re-restored because of the failure of root canal treatment. Residual 160 onlays (95.2%) had smooth and completed margin. No crack and no discolor. Conclusion: onlay/partial crown is an effective way to restore and protect posterior teeth after endodontic treatment.</p> <p>Key words: onlay/partial crown, endodontic treatment</p>
